Little League Has Rules for Umpires

Little League rules specify that at least one staff umpire must be available to work before a game can be started.

If a staff umpire is not available then one other than a member of the staff can be used only by mutual agreement of the managers of both teams which will be playing.

It is the recommendation of Little League Headquarters that two umpires be provided for each game if at all possible.

Even the umpires have at least one restricting rule in Little League. They are not permitted to wear shoes with metal cleats on them.
