Story of Water is Endless Life Game of 'Put & Take'

In this age of push-button automation man might consider himself monarch of the earth. Through his scientific advancements he can conserve and stretch natural resources to meet many needs. More correctly, it enters here, however, for first there must be a source of supply. This is where nature prominently enters Michigan's water picture. More correctly, it entered the scene millions of years ago when the earth was still in its infancy. This marked the beginning of that never-ending water cycle — the "wheel" of water movement on which life depends.

Through the process of evaporation the atmosphere is continually absorbing water from the surface of the oceans, lakes, streams, and the soil. Added to this is the moisture drawn from the ground and exhaled by leaves of trees and other vegetation. As the air is cooled, moisture condenses in clouds preparing for its return journey to the earth. Michigan's average annual precipitation is about 39 inches. This figure varies widely from locality to locality and from year to year. When precipitation falls as rain, several things happen. Part of it soaks into the ground, part runs off the ground to lakes, streams, springs, or other surface waters. Some of the water seeping into the ground is held as soil moisture. A large portion is drawn from the soil by the

thirsty roots of trees, shrubs and other vegetation. SURPLUS water escaping parts only which rises to the "water table" which is the surface of a zone where all openings between earth particles are full of water—ground water.

From this zone, ground water is always overflowing into surface outlets. Most of these outlets are the vast network of streams and rivers which are maintained during the summer by the steady, slight upwelling of this cold, residue, hill streams don't water the land in Michigan, they drain it.

Approximately two-thirds (two-thirds) of Michigan's annual precipitation never reaches these surface waters. Evaporation and vegetation take all but 10 inches.
