Want More Miles from the 'Old Buggy'?

Looking for some better gas mileage from that old buggy of yours?

Here are some suggestions which may help you get at least a few extra miles out of your per gallon.

1. Engine tune-up. Tune it every 5,000 to 10,000 miles. Capriolator, and timing adjusters, valves, and other spark-plugs need needed.
2. Brake adjustment. Check periodically to see that wheels turn freely with no binding or dragging.
3. Wheel alignment. Watch front tires for signs of faulty alignment.
4. Air pressures. Keep tires inflated at least to recommended pressures; three or four pounds above will save a little gas.
5. Accelerate moderately. Avoid abrupt starts, most gas is consumed in getting the car moving from a standstill.
6. Shift up to top gear as early as possible. Change to the economy gear; stay in it as much as possible.
7. Keep a constant speed. Anticipate slowing traffic and idling, when the brakes are used, gas is wasted.
8. Idle sparingly. An idling engine wastes a penny's worth of gas every four minutes.

Tips to Avoid Food Poisoning

Food poisoning can result easily in hot weather.

Authorities suggest that a good rule to follow is to keep food cool, keep it cold or frozen, keep it. Keeping food cold means refrigeration at a temperature of 40 to 50 degrees or lower.

The cause of food poisoning is germs growing in food. These germs multiply rapidly when certain foods are kept at room temperature and produce a poison. In as short a time as an hour or two food may become unfit to eat without any noticeable change in taste or odor. Special care should be given to fish, meat - whether raw, precooked or cooked - milk, potato and other salad, cream fillings, custards, and puddings.

Food poisoning can be a serious illness. The symptoms of the most common type of food poisoning are chills, nausea and vomiting. These symptoms appear approximately two and one-half to four hours after the food is eaten. If the food is not kept refrigerated at all times, picnic food should be kept cool and cold while it is being prepared and kept refrigerated until transferred to an insulated container or packed in ice for transportation. Keep the refrigerated picnic foods covered and put them in the shade until they are eaten.

The care and cleanliness when ever you prepare food. Wash your hands and face before you touch food and make sure that all dishes, mixing forks, spoons and pans are thoroughly clean.

The authorities say it is often impossible to tell the spoiling of food, so that you should use care and cleanliness and keep foods refrigerated or hot until they are eaten.

Take advantage of fresh vegetables and fruits as they come in season, but be sure they are thoroughly washed before you eat them, is another tip given.

Tips to Avoid Carbon Poison Accidents Given

When temperatures go down, your chances of falling victim to carbon monoxide poisoning are increased, says Dr. Albert E. Heustis, state health commissioner.

But there are several precautions you can take to protect yourself against this deadly gas, he added. Most of them apply to automobiles and the use of carbon fuels in stoves and heaters.

Carbon fuels include coal, charcoal, coke wood, oil, gasoline, kerosene, natural gas and wood.

Some carbon monoxide is formed whenever carbon-containing materials are burned. The amount of carbon monoxide produced depends on the air supply. If venting is inadequate, the deadly gas is carried away without causing harm to carbon monoxide gas.

Michigan of carbon monoxide poisoning, almost all of them inside cars or buildings where the carbon fuel is being burned improperly or exhausted improperly.

To protect yourself inside a car, the health department recommended these precautions:

- 1-Leave your car's exhaust system checked and repaired or replaced if necessary. If the muffler is clogged, the right carbon monoxide will leak up through the floorboards.
- 2-In cold weather, always drive with a window or vent partly open so fresh air can get in.
- 3-Never run a car's engine inside a closed garage or other building.

To protect yourself inside your home:

- 1-Check all stoves, heaters, space heaters and gas furnaces to make sure that they are adjusted and vented properly. If you don't know how to do this, get someone who does.
- 2-Don't install water heaters where air doesn't circulate, such as in closets that are kept closed.

An increasing number of carbon monoxide accidents have been occurring during cold weather at motels and cabins, the health department said. These places protect their guests against accidental carbon monoxide poisoning, the health department has just issued a pamphlet entitled "Carbon Monoxide Hazard."

Frozen Rolls

You can make brown and serve rolls at home, says the Detroit Consumer Marketing Information A. g. e. n. t. Simply bake yeast rolls until they have reached their maximum volume and begin to brown. Remove them immediately, let them cool and store them in the freezer. When you wish to serve the rolls, remove them from the freezer and pop them into the oven. A brief heating at four hundred degrees Fahrenheit will turn them golden brown.
