"Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed each year against property in Farmington Public School District, Oakland County, Nichigan, for all purposes except taxes for the pay-ment of interest and principal on obligations incurred prior to Dec. 8, 1932, be increased as provided in Sec-tion 21 of Article X of the Constitution of Mitchigan, for a period of five (5) years from 1960 to 1964, both inclusive, by two mills on each dollar (82.00 per \$1,000) of the assessed valuation as equalized, for the purpose of paying a part of the operating expenses of said school distribut?".
