**Nursery Costs
Up But Plants
Still Inexpensive**

nts can be sold for so little naturally, much preparation and expense is necessary before planting is even started. The selection and purchasing of land, buildings, greenhouse, and frames and equipment are costly and essential and necessary before any planting started.

Preparing the land for nursery crops takes several years. The soil must be right because the plants will be growing from three to eight years. Some stock requires even a

Many of the best shade trees require several years of growing before the whips are transplanted to the field and most then require staking for one or two years. They also

must be pruned one or two times annually. Some varieties will withstand the shock of transplanting better than others. Some must be dug with a ball of earth and wrapped in burlap, while others need to be cut and potted or planted for safe moving from a nursery to the home. Evergreens are the favorite shrub for the modern home. Most evergreens are started in root-heels. After they are well-rooted they are transplanted into beds to grow for one or two years. Often they are

transplanted into another bed to remain for several more years. Then they are ready to be transplanted into the field where they will grow from two to eight years longer. During this time, the evergreen requires root pruning several times, depending on the variety. A good, well developed plant must be sheared at least once a year from the first year until it is big and sold.

Digging and balling evergreens and shade trees requires careful handling. No mach-

It has been invented to prune or shear a tree or shrub, on to the many other jobs in the nursery.

It is hard to believe that many plants are only a little higher in price now than during the 1930's, even though the cost of everything a nurseryman uses in his business has gone up yearly.
