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A Review of 1959 News Highlights

school operating budget for the 1959-60 school year was approved by the Farmington Board of Education Monday night. This tentative budget is \$387,111 higher than the budget for 1958-59. The school system has been operating during the current school year. A building permit was taken out last Friday for construction of a new American Bakeries distribution depot on Nine Mile Road between Farmington and Gilf roads.

April 23
The proposed Farmington Interceptor Sewer project has been delayed at least 60 days by legal entanglements. A State Supreme Court ruling on the legality of the procedure was delayed weeks and weeks by school games through last week. Last week State Senator L. Harvey Lodge introduced a bill in the legislature which would remove this legal barrier. It is hoped that this bill will be passed quickly and given immediate effect. This is why it is believed the delay may be no more than 60 days.

Transactions have now been completed by the Farmington School District for a 42 acre rural high school site on 15 Mile just east of Farmington Road. The land was purchased at a price of \$2,800 per acre. A condemnation proceedings were not necessary.

April 30
Reporting Tuesday night on suggestions that Thompson Brown Company might donate 10 acres of land at Twelve Mile and Power Road for a township center. Supervisor Curt Hall read a letter written by the company to former Supervisor Frank Stephenson, dated March 19, which clearly pointed out the company's position. After discussion, the Township Board voted to table the matter for future study.

Collection of the \$250 tap-in charges for the Farmington Interceptor Sewer will be considered at the next Township Board meeting. West Bloomfield Township and Keego Harbor are already collecting the charge and putting it into a special fund. Supervisor Hall stated that he hoped to have a proposed ordinance for the collections set up for consideration by the next meeting date.

May
The city's proposal to increase its tax rate 25 per cent next year may be considered Monday night. Councilmen met again Tuesday night to review figures. Some 75 men and women attended the municipal building for the budget hearing and to voice their protests.

May 14
The proposed Farmington city budget and its 25 per cent increase failed passage Monday night by a 3-2 vote of the city council. The council will hold another public meeting Friday evening, May 15, in an attempt to agree on items which must be cut out of the proposed budget.

May 21
Sale of bonds for the Farmington Interceptor Sewer will be held next week. May 28, if the bids are favorable then bidding is expected to get underway within a few days after the contracts are let.

May 28
Bonds for the Farmington Interceptor Sewer were sold Tuesday. The sale was held at the Farmington Planning Board. The sale was a success and most of the six contractors involved in the big project were expected to start work next week.

May 28
A start has been made to clean-up uncleanly and unhealthy conditions in Farmington Township. In the last three months approximately 90 homes in the township have been contacted regarding unkept homes and grounds and many unsanitary conditions. Supervisor Curt Hall stated. The drive is being continued.

June 4
During the coming week, diplomas will be awarded to 362 seniors at commencement exercises at the Farmington High School in the Farmington area. Farmington High will graduate 220. Clarenceville High, 84 and Our Lady of Sorrows High School in the Farmington area. Farmington township will get the same millage as last year from the 15-mill tax pie. This is the limit that can be levied without approval by a vote of the people, according to state law. Several increases beyond the limit have already been approved for the Farmington public school system.

June 11
Plans are now being made for a special township election this fall at which time taxpayers will have an opportunity to vote on a proposed one mill special tax levy to be used for the improvement of township roads. Supervisor Curt Hall stated that he feels the township roads have gotten in pretty bad shape and need for considerable ditching, grading and graveling is necessary. Voter interest in this area was at its lowest ebb in many years for the school elections on Monday. Residents in both the Farmington and Clarenceville school districts were returned to office. Only 1,025 votes were cast in Farmington and only 249 in Clarenceville.

June 18
National Food Store at the Bel-Aire Shopping Center is enjoying its grand reopening this week. The store was entirely rebuilt following a big fire there earlier this year.

Two zoning changes were completed Monday by the Township Planning Board. The zoning changes want to build additional stores of the service type plus a medical center. The zoning granted was for additional parking area to permit this. Earlier an area for building had been approved just north of Kroger's. This has now been approved.

June 25
School taxes will run approximately 12 per cent higher for property owners in the Farmington School District this year than last. The 1959 debt service tax levy was set by the School Board at 12 mills (\$12.00 state equalized valuation). The debt service tax rate last year was 8.7 mills or 3.3 mills lower.
