The next meeting of the Quers Club will be February 22 at 12:30 at Mrs. George Newman's home on Power Rd.

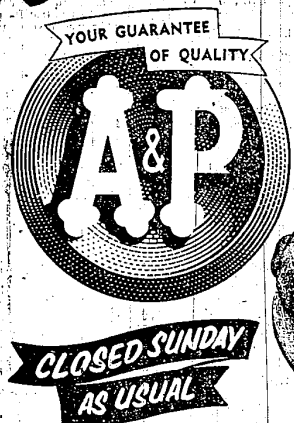

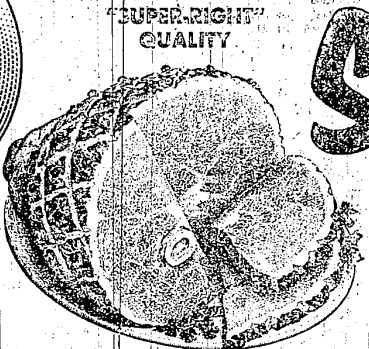
