This would be the 75% sewage charge, bringing the total quarterly water bill to \$3.75. CHECKING THE water bills of two or three personal friends, we found this average to be low compared to theirs and proceeded to determine why. As was stated, this 14,500 gallon figure was an average, taking into account all different types of users. Included would be the older couples living alone in an old established home and using very little water as well as the younger couples with families using an above-average amount of water.

The average family is figured to be one comprised of between three and one-half to four people. It is quite logical to assume, therefore, that a couple having four children would consume an above average amount of water. If this was a family having young children then the amount of water used would probably be slightly more than that used by a family with the same number of older children.

As can be seen, a lot of things must be taken into consideration when comparing your own bill with the average bill referred to here. How does Farmington City's water bills, for an average 14,500 gallon user, compare with those in neighboring communities? In the City of Southfield, an average 14,500 gallon water user would pay \$4.97 for the water plus \$2.10 in a 70c a month meter charge and a minimum of \$1.22 for sewage obligations or a total of \$8.29, Engineer Papke said. In Birmingham this same user would pay \$5.63 for his water and \$3.31 as a sewage charge or a total of \$8.94 quarterly. The rate in Livonia varies considerably from one area to another. Papke said, a Livonia resident using 14,500 gallons of water would pay \$4.60 for water consumed and a minimum sewage charge of 92c. For some areas this might be the total bill while in others the additional amount charged for retirement of water main obligations might run as high as \$4.50 more, he commented.

ALL THREE of these neighboring communities have water supply to them by Detroit. What would be some of the advantages to us as individuals for having a Detroit water supply instead of our present well water supply? The city officials we spoke with mentioned many. Major among these was the savings that could be realized because of the fact that Detroit water is much softer than that now coming from our own system.

Those without softening units would save substantially on soap and cleanser bills and have far better looking sinks and basins with soft Detroit water, it was pointed out. Those renting water softening units could save from \$50 a year up since it would no longer be necessary to rent a softening unit, was another comment.

THERE WOULD also be some savings for those who have already purchased a softening unit of their own, although it might take some time to recover the money spent for the unit. It was figured by the city engineer that about a dollar a month could be saved in softener salt costs. Time and effort in taking care of softener units would also be eliminated and there would be some savings in water costs since additional water for back-washing and re-charging would no longer be needed, Engineer Papke said.

The school property tax levy. This is based on a total operating levy of 19 mills. Ten of these are assured, having been approved by votes of the people in the school district over the past years. Whether all of the other nine mills for operating will be allowed remains to be seen.

The proposed budget must now be submitted to the County Allocation Board. Last year the tax allocation body allowed the local district only \$2.2 million in operating funds from state sources with the remaining approximately 2 per cent from miscellaneous sources.
