### 15 KILLED IN HOTEL FIRE

Many Guests Are Caught as Roof Collapses in Omaha Fire.

Fire, believed to have been caused, by a gas explosion, cost, 15 or more lives in Omaha, Neb, and caused a loss of \$250,000. The Dewey hotel, a second class hostery at Thirteenth and Farnam streets, who destroyed by fire which swept the three-story building with a speed that precluded attempts at resear. Some of the guests had time to reach the statuway, but others were caught by the collapsing roof of the structure before they could be rescued from window sills on which they had taken refuge.
