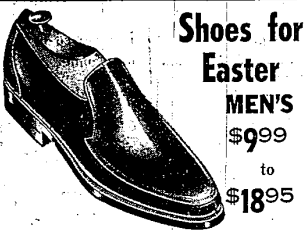


**The Old Timer**

## Clinic Held For Educators

Attention of educators in Southeastern Michigan focused Thursday, March 21, on Oakland County's efforts to improve the teaching of history, geography, economics and government in the public schools. Eighty superintendents and curriculum experts of the Elementary School Improvement Committee of the Metropolitan Bureau of School Studies attended an all-day clinic devoted to the social studies at the Oakland County Schools offices in Pontiac.

Dr. Myles M. Platt, County social studies director, used closed circuit television to explain the development of Oakland County's concept-based curriculum in the social studies.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS assumed a double role of students and teachers during the afternoon session of the clinic. They watched a videotaped history lesson and filled out two quiz sheets. One set of questions was on the subject matter covered in the lesson. A second group of questions sought their evaluation of the effectiveness of the teaching.

Following the test, the educators formed groups to make sample lessons using film strips, movies, and records for maximum impact on the student.

Assisting Dr. Platt in the social studies clinic were Mrs. Helen Jesse of the Pontiac Schools, Mrs. Sally Holmes, Martha Bailey, Southfield Farmington Schools, and Mrs. Schools. The three are classroom teachers assigned by their school districts to the social studies development program.
