## Christian Educators At Baptist Assembly

Green Lake, Wisconsin  
Christian educators are gathered at the American Baptist Assembly, Green Lake, Wisconsin, this week for the purpose of preparing themselves to witness effectively as Christians in today's world of tension and confusion.

Among the 400 church school administrators, teachers and other interested laymen attending the National Christian Education Conference are Mr. and Mrs. Stephen P. Melnek and children, 33385 Brittain Dr., Farmington, members of Covenant Baptist Church in Detroit.

THROUGH messages by guest speakers, small Bible study groups, and discussion courses the educators are being confronted with the seriousness of living as Christians amid revolution and crisis. Many phases of the church's ministry, including family life education, are being discussed in these study groups.

Dr. John E. Skoglund, Professor of Preaching at Colgate Rochester Divinity School, Rochester, New York, is delivering a series of morning lectures, based on the conference theme, "Mission to the World: Witness in a World of International Crisis." The text of these lectures is related to his book entitled "The Whole Creation." The vesper leader for this August 17-24 conference is Dr. Richard Cummings, Secretary of Public Relations, American Baptist Foreign Mission Societies.

Evening programs include the film "All the Way Home"; a panel discussion on service opportunities which will focus upon the Peace Corps; and two addresses by Dr. Samuel D. Long, Associate Director of the United States Peace Corps. The director of this conference is Dr. James E. Fidler, Director, Department of Leadership Education, American Baptist Foreign Mission Societies.
