Alvin Johnson of Grand Forks, N.D., is serving as an intern at the Southfield Community Church, 21222 Indian (between Beech and Inkster, north of Eight Mile Road) in preparation for missionary work in Guatemala, according to Pastor Raymond Bayne. Under appointment by the General American Mission, Mr. Johnson completed his schooling with a degree in education at Teacher's College in North Dakota, following his service in the Armed Forces. He then took specialized Bible and Missionary training at the Bible Institute of the Oak Hills Fellowship in Bemidji, Minnesota, graduating in the spring of this year.

ALONG WITH OVER 100 other missionary applicants, Mr. Johnson is working in the Detroit area under the supervision of Missionary Internship Incorporated, a school specializing in the final training of missionary candidates after they have finished their formal schooling in accredited colleges and Bible institutions and seminaries. Field experience is an essential part of the internship training.
Mr. Johnson has been assigned to the Southfield Community Church, where he will work under the supervision of Pastor Bayne, doing visitation work, youth work and office work in the church. The course lasts for seven months.
