Will Instruct Adult Ed Class

An Adult Education Course in patents, trademarks and copyrights will be taught by Detroit patent attorney Bernard J. Cantor of Farmington, at the Oak Park High School on Tuesday evenings from 7:30 p.m. beginning February 3. The course is sponsored by the Management and Technology Center of Wayne State University. To enroll, call RE. 1-7885 and request information and enrollment forms.
THE COURSE was previously taught by Mr. Cantor at the Wayne Campus and is now being given, for the first time, in Oak Park. It is designed for inventors, business men, engineers and others, whose work or interest includes new inventions, patents, and placing new products on the market.
The course will include how to protect new ideas, what can be patented and how patents are obtained and used. Also included will be protecting trademarks, copyrights and trade secrets.
MR. CANTOR, a resident of 29746 Highmeadow Road, Farmington, is an engineering graduate of Cornell University and holds a Doctor of Law degree from George Washington University. From 1949 to 1952, he was employed as a Patent Examiner in the United States Patent Office. Now a member of the Detroit firm of Cullen, Slonim & Cantor, he is the author of numerous articles on the subject of patent law.
