PROPOSITION I: MILLAGE INCREASE PROPOSITION

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes, which may be assessed against all real and tangible personal property within the CLARENCEVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF OAKLAND AND WAYNE COUNTIES, MICHIGAN, for all purposes, be increased, as provided in Section 6, Article IX, of the Michigan Constitution of 1963, by TWO (2) MILL (2 1/2% of 1%) on each dollar of the assessed valuation of property, to be levied, for a period of five (5) years from 1964 to 1968, both inclusive, to be used only for the purpose of paying general operating expenses of the said School District?
