The B.P.O. Elks under the direction of Exalted Ruler James Harris will conduct a March of Dimes penny sale, an annual affair also undertaken by the Elks for the second year.

THE FARMINGTON Area has thirteen residents currently receiving March of Dimes aid, with another thirteen eligible for participation. During the past ten years the local Chapter has spent \$13,538.15 in direct patient care, with \$24,251 distributed to 1,714 in Oakland County during the first ten months of 1963.

The work of the March of Dimes has been tremendously increased since the program of research into the causes of birth defects and arthritis have been added to the continuing study and care of polio patients.

portion of the property. Planning will therefore be seeking change in the zoning on the property to a residential and office district zoning classification instead of the originally requested multiple family re-zoning.

COUNCILMAN Henry Forrest questioned the right of Planning to abandon his original re-zoning petition and immediately petition for another type of re-zoning.

Lengthy discussion followed with various sections of the City Charter being cited but the matter still seemed to be somewhat unresolved when discussion was concluded.

It was generally agreed that since no official public hearing on the petition for re-zoning the property to multiple-family use had been held a re-zoning request change was perfectly in order. Only Councilman Forrest was not in agreement on this matter.

Fleming's request for R-10 zoning on this parcel will now go to the Planning Commission for study and a recommendation. Public hearings on this new request will have to be held before any zoning change can be granted.
