**Area Children Cared For by U.F. Hospital**  
Children's Hospital of Michigan, Torchi Drive, are caring for 63 Farmington children as inpatients and six in its clinic services during the last two years. Two patients were referred from Farmington Township.  
Children's is a voluntary nonprofit hospital under a Board of Trustees who volunteer their services.  
It is staffed by 300 physicians who are specialists in the care of children, and 50 full-time nurses who are continuing their required training. These doctors devote their time to patient care, teaching and research.  
ALL PATIENTS up to 12 years of age who need its services are admitted to Children's Hospital, whether or not they pay. Two-thirds of the inpatients at Children's have no insurance or other means to pay most of all their hospital bills. One-third are eligible for State Aid. Only 2 percent have no resources.  
Last year, Children's provided 8,248 patient days service to 8,856 patients whose average stay was 7.7 days. On an average day, there were 187 patients in 215 beds.  
In the clinics, the situation is reversed. Only 2 percent pay the full rate. Another 70 percent pay something, and 28 percent receive help from Aid to Dependent Children or Welfare.  
The hospital receives no payment from either the State or the County or the State for Outpatient care.  
It is to make sure that sick injured children may receive needed care regardless of ability to pay that Torchi Drive dollars are made available.  
Not only does Children's provide the modern surgical and medical services possible, but also sees to the happiness of its patients by creating an atmosphere of relaxed sociability and avoiding restrictions as much as possible.  
The new Abrams Planetarium at Michigan State University is the first in the United States to show outer space as it would appear to a space traveler going to the moon. This feature gives it a potential as a tool for training astronauts.
