This is the first year a men's softball league has been formed in the City and reports are that

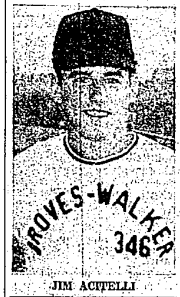
Kraft and Acitelli Top Legion Team Batsmen
