

# PRIMARY CANDIDATES FOR STATE SENATE AND HOUSE

## 5 Republicans Pose Primary Election Fight

There are a total of eight candidates running for election in the new 14th State House District, three Democrats and five Republicans. Since it is a new district, there is no incumbent. The 14th State Senate District includes all of the cities and townships of Farmington, Plymouth and Northampton, in addition to that portion of Oakland County west of the townships of Brandon, Independence, Waterford, Bloomfield and Southfield. Also included in the District are the cities of Sylvan Lake and Keego Harbor.



F. Prescott

Fitzhugh Prescott of Farmington, a Republican, is a businessman, president of a fertilizer company, and in the past has been associated as a sales engineer with the steel industry and as a packaging engineer with the paper industry. He is 40 years old, married and has one child.

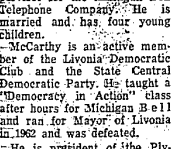
This is Prescott's second venture into politics. He was first active in politics during the 1962 Presidential election campaign, in support of General Eisenhower.

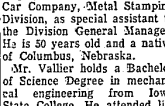

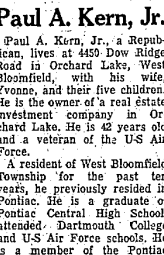

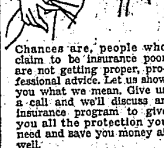
C. Wagenschutz

Wagenschutz, 59, is a widower and the father of four children.

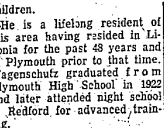
