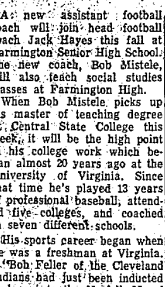

Former Pro Baseball Pitcher To Join Coaching Staff at FHS



A new assistant football coach will join head football coach Ed Sadowski at Farmington Senior High School. The new coach, Bob Mistle, will also teach social studies classes at Farmington High. When Bob Mistle began his master of teaching degree at Central State College this week, it will be the high point in his college work which began almost 20 years ago at the University of Virginia. Since that time he has played 13 years of professional baseball, attended five colleges, and coached in seven different schools. His sports career began when he was a freshman at Virginia. Bob Mistle, of the Cleveland Indians, had been in the major leagues and sent to the Norfolk Naval Base, Mistle recalls. "Someone got up a game between the Indians and the Cleveland Indians. I was elected to pitch against them. I pitched a shutout." "UP TO THAT TIME, I had pitched a total of 10 games in my life. I can't imagine how I felt!" the athlete said. "But we won 2 to 1!" As word got around, he was called to several home parks to work out and he signed with the Chicago White Sox where he played for three years. Following World War II he pitched for the Chicago White Sox. Later, after he began high school coaching, Mistle played semi-pro ball with Elk City.

One "record" he's proud of. In 13 years of baseball, he never once played on Sunday. A Baptist, he takes his religion seriously. He did his pitching on the other six days. Continuing his college work Mistle managed along with his baseball tours, one semester a student at Western College in Illinois; Wayne State, Detroit; Park Junior College, Park, Tex.; Oklahoma University, and Central State. Mistle played with his baseball, the young pitcher managed to play four years of college football as a quarterback, leading to his second career as a football coach. MISTLE COACHED his first high school team at Bogota, Tex., in 1948 followed by two years at Gary, Ind. After a year at Central where he completed his bachelor's degree in 1951, his coaching career led him from Marion, Ohio, to Detroit, then to Brownsville, Tex. After coaching at Classen for three years, 1956-58, the mentor moved to Sterling College in Kansas where he has coached for the past three years. This fall he begins a new position as assistant football coach for the high school at Farmington, Mich. "A native of Detroit, Mistle says he's looking forward to living in his home state for the first time since 1946. "But I like Oklahoma," the coach hastened to add. "And Central State is my second home. The people here are the friendliest I've found anywhere."

MRS. MISTLE (the former Louise Lowry of Oklahoma City) and her husband, four youngsters are already in their new home - a 1 1/2 year-old "farmstead" home on two acres.

"We have all kinds of fruit trees, lots of space, and even pheasants in the back yard," Mistle said. "The kids and I do love it!"

As a hobby, the athlete enjoys car races, but only as a spectator. His first and last experience as a driver came after he'd qualified in the mid-levels for a 100 mile in Toledo. "I had caught me just before the race," Mistle recalled with a chuckle. "And that was the end of my racing career."

SERIOUS AGAIN, Mistle said he and his wife attended the International 100 race at Indianapolis as guests of Eddie Sachs - the driver who was killed in the famous wreck. "What a thrill," Mistle said, "an exciting day turned out to be a tragic one," said the coach. "But Eddie always said that his time came that's the way he went to go, I guess they all do."

State Police officers made 16,149 arrests in June 14,458 for traffic offenses and 1,691 on criminal complaints, according to the department's monthly activity report.

In addition, 493 juveniles were arrested for traffic violations and 528 delinquent minors apprehended.

Protopopov assisted 5,018 motorists investigated 7,727 cars, gave 19,018 oral warnings and made 2,061 liquor and 10,347 property inspections.

STATE PATROL vehicles traveled 1,022,973 miles, of which 902,877 were on "traffic patrol" and 109,996 to investigate criminal offenses. 222 examinations of the identification bureau received 13,046 sets of fingerprints, of which 7,264 were criminal and 5,782 noncriminal. Twenty-three wanted persons were identified.

Of 1,995 applications for permits to carry concealed weapons, 234 were identified with fingerprints.

One unknown dead was identified by the same means.

THE SCIENTIFIC crime laboratory conducted 228 examinations, of which 235 were on questioned documents, 106 microscopic, 72 on firearms, 30 on footprints, 45 on miscellaneous.

Crime laboratory assistance numbered 43 for State Police, 10 for a bureau, and a division, 33 for local police departments, 10 for sheriffs, and 10 for state and federal departments. Four investigations at the scene included two deaths.

Of the 416 drownings on which official reports have been received, 23 were swimmers or waders, 23 boat operators, 23 boat passengers, 23 on Scuba divers, 9 fell through ice, 17 fell from a bridge, bank, dock or pier, 1 fell into a caisson and 3 died attempting to rescue another.

"WATER SAFETY is just as important as traffic safety and it is dismaying that there has been such a big increase in drownings," Commissioner Joseph A. Childs said. "And, as in the case of traffic deaths, most could be prevented with August still remaining of the summer season, I cannot stress too strongly observing water safety rules. As I have said before, enjoy the water but respect it."

Childs emphasized that there be life preservers on boats, that boats not be overloaded or improperly operated, that swimmers never swim alone, swim only in waters they know and never in gravel pits, and that when children are in or near the water there should be constant adult supervision.

Family Size Is Very Important

A doctor last week defined family planning as a "responsible, informed, positive type of planning directed toward the development of a happy, healthy family."

Dr. Hermann A. Ziel Jr., chief of the Maternal Health Section of the Michigan Department of Health, was addressing an audience of homemakers during Michigan State University's annual College Week for Women.

Limiting his talk primarily to a discussion of family size but emphasizing that family planning goes well beyond this consideration, Dr. Ziel stated that family size cannot help but have an influence on the happiness and health of the individual family.

"When family size exceeds family means," he said, "the family must face the problems of housing, food, recreation, education and other more or less essential items they are denied members of the family."

Dr. Ziel pointed out that studies show that too many and too frequent pregnancies decrease the child's chances for life and health.

His statement that parents must not only be able to decide the ultimate size of their family, but they must also be able to decide just when children should be added to the family.

He described various methods of birth control but stated that books, pamphlets and programs can provide only background information. He stressed that parents must be willing to accomplish or prevent pregnancy. Specific information, he said, should be obtained from a physician or through a clinic.

He stated that the medical direction and where the information provided meets the specific needs of the individual parent.
