

Area Plumbing Inspector Dies
George Huger, 64, of 5190 Seven Mile Road, South Lyon, plumbing inspector for Plymouth city and township and Northville city and township, died Feb. 8 in Ridgewood Hospital after a short illness.

City, Township Clerks Predict Light Vote
Although the last minute discrediting campaign against City Attorney Edward Draugelis, questioning his eligibility, may have some effect on the vote, neither City Clerk Richard Shafer nor Township Clerk John McEwen are looking for much action at the polls Monday.
The Township has only one issue on the ballot, selection of nominees for the 14th district State Senatorial seat and McEwen predicts less than a 20 per cent vote — something less than 800.
Shafer feels interest in the primary is at an extremely low point in the City and believes it will be less than 15 per cent or around 750.
