Keep Your Child Well, Arrange Immunization Now!

For 10 years there has been a group of community-minded women who have operated a Child Health Conference in Livonia known as the Well Baby Clinic.

This Clinic serves Redford Township, Plymouth, Nankin, Garden City and Livonia babies from three months to five years for a small fee. There is no financial stigma attached to the clinic.

Any child in this age category who resides in out-lying areas is invited to at-tend the clinic the first and second Wednesday of each month at St. Paul's Presby-terian Church Parish House, Five Mile and Cavell in Livonia. The Livonia Health Guild as-sisted to a limited extent by Wayne County Department of Health support the clinic.

The clinic is held in clean, pleasant surroundings and each child is treated by the doctor on each visit, for which a fee of \$1.00 per child, where feasi-ble, is collected by the Depart-ment of Health. None of this revenue reverts to the clinic.

The doctor is a pediatrician from University Hospital, Ann Arbor. As much time is spent with each child by the doctor as is deemed necessary to com-pletely satisfy the needs of the child, the mother and the doctor. Referrals are made to appropriate agencies when need-ed. Supplemental vitamins are provided gratis where indicated. Public Health follow-up is also included in the service.

Preventive immunization starts with a primary series of vaccine for diphtheria, tetanus and whooping cough (DPT's) in con-junction with Salk vaccine at 3 months. Reads small-pox vac-cination is given at 4 to 5 months at the discretion of the physician in charge. At 9

months to 1 year a booster of the DPT and Salk vaccine is given. A booster is administered again at 2 years and again at 5 years prior to entrance to school. A repeat small-pox vac-cination is given at 5 years also.

Ideally, too, a physical exam-ination is given at 3, 6, 9, 12, 18 and 24 months, again at 3 and 4 years. The preschool examina-tion is done at 5 years. All help, with the exception of the supervisory and the doctor, are unpaid volunteers, even the RN who assists the doctor. All equipment with the excep-tion of the immunizing material and the clerical supplies is pro-vided by the Health Guild. Only source of income to cover these expenditures are monetary gifts by local organizations. Clinics are open from 1 to 3

p.m. at St. Paul's. For an ap-pointment or more information call Mrs. Clifford Johnson, GA 1-0386.
