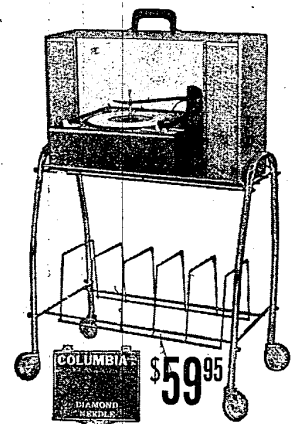

For the past two years Junior High School students and their parents have had the opportunity to participate in a Sex Education Program sponsored by the Farmington Area YMCA. Many students, however, missed out on this program because they were in Senior High School or the program had reached its quota for the number of people who could participate.

Due to the tremendous response and interest expressed by students, parents, and the Farmington Community for this Sex Ed. Program, the YMCA will sponsor a Senior High School series on Sex Education.

The team of Dr. Ed. Blumberg, a practicing physician in Farmington; Reverend Richard Markham, a pastor at First Farmington Methodist Church; and Dr. Paul Kaufman, a clinical psychologist at Hawthorne Hospital in Northville will again conduct the program.

## Republicans Answer Democratic Charges
