Township Board Plans Law Suit

Farmington Township will bring suit against the Plyer Trucking Co. at 31006 Orchard Lake Rd. for violation of the ordinance.

The Township Board, at its meeting Monday night, authorized Township Attorney Joseph T. Brennan to seek a permanent injunction in the new State Circuit Court against the firm.

Township Supervisor Curt

Hall told the Board that the firm had been in violation for over a year. The current zoning ordinance for the section is 12 and such a trucking business is not permitted under the ordinance.

The establishment is located in Orchard Lake Rd. just south of 14 Mile Rd.

In other business the Board:

- Unanimously passed a resolution supporting House Bill 2169 introduced by Farmington's representative Ray Baker. The bill, which is currently being considered by the House Public Safety committee, would provide that "local authorities may decrease the speed limits to a speed not less than 15 miles per hour on streets and roads abutting or running through school grounds." The speed limit could be enforced not more than 1/2 hour before and a 1/2 hour after school hours.

- Heard a report on the planned facilities for Oakland County Community College campus at 1696 and Orchard Lake Road.

- Approved the zoning change of the southwest corner of Halsted and Twelve Mile Rd. from B1 to B2.

- Set May 8 and 15 as clean up — pick up days in the Township and provided for all kinds of debris to be picked up by the rubbish contractor on those dates.

- Rezoned a part of the Botsford ten land from B4A to B2 and another portion of the same area to B3.

Cornwell's Importance Is Assured

In his bid for a seat on the Farmington City Council, builder-developer Virgil Cornwell drew a total of 753 votes. This newspaper did not carry that fact in its post-election coverage.

This was an oversight, and not a reflection of Mr. Cornwell's significance to the community.

As the builder of the New Farmington Center, his contribution to Farmington will be writ in large letters in any future history of Farmington.

In the course of the recent campaign, one that became increasingly rough and personal, no one stood up to question Cornwell's integrity, and dedication to his chosen community, or his competence at his chosen profession.

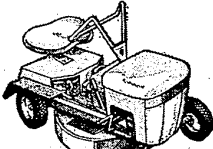

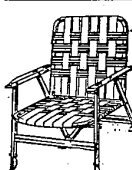

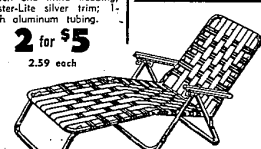
