

Industries Show Confidence in Michigan With Expansion Progress

LANSING — Expenditures of \$6,539,000 for new plant facilities were announced by Michigan companies during the first quarter of this year, B. M. Conboy, director of the Michigan Economic Expansion Department, announces. The 1964 total for new plant facilities by Michigan firms was \$1.6 billion.

"While the first quarter report indicates expansion of facilities by Michigan firms is moving along at a record rate, it is still too early to forecast what the total for the full year 1965 will be," Conboy said.

"Last year's total included a very large amount by General Motors to be spread over a three-year period. However, the first quarter does indicate our economy is still very strong and moving along at a very satisfactory rate."

Manufacturing firms announced \$237,909,000 of the first quarter expansions; utilities, \$256,435,000; and non-manufacturing companies \$39,025,000.

A familiar pattern holds true in the expansion of Michigan companies. Most of the growth is coming from firms already established in Michigan. Moves account for a small part of the overall growth total.

"This barometer shows industries are doing well in Michigan, confident of their future here and are not hesitating to commit their expansion funds to Michigan locations," Conboy said.

The Michigan Economic Expansion Department long has recognized that emphasis to promote more industry should be concentrated on companies already doing business in the State. However, the department works closely with companies outside Michigan planning to expand.

Two unusually interesting move-ins of this type were announced in the first quarter. Beech-Nut Life Savers, Inc., will build a \$10 million plant at Holland and employ 200 people. American Playground Device Company, of Anderson, Indiana, will move its entire operations from Anderson, Ind., to Yama, the former lumber town on Lake Michigan, bringing 200 more jobs to the Upper Peninsula.

Significantly, no move-outs were recorded in the first quarter.

The Economic Expansion Department movement of industry report for the first quarter, which includes move-ins, expansions within and without the State, was 50 per cent favorable, up slightly from the 1964 full year rate. This is another favorable indicator for the Michigan economy.

There were 48 expansions by Michigan companies at present locations, five at other locations in the State, five new starts and one reopening.

Among the major expansions announced by Michigan industries in the first quarter, were:

Chrysler Corporation, \$187 million.

Michigan Bell Telephone Co., \$129 million.

KVP Sutherland Paper Company, Kalamazoo, \$25 million over next five years.

Kaydon Engineering Corporation, Muskegon, \$2.5 million.

Consumers Power Company, \$92 million.

Deviling Machine Company, Royal Oak, \$700,000.

Peet Packing Company, Cheesaning, \$500,000.

Non-Teachers Get Pay Raise

The Farmington Board of Education approved the 1965-66 salary schedules with additional benefits for all non-teaching personnel at their meeting Monday evening.

The secretarial staff will receive an across-the-board improvement with minimum and maximums in each classification up \$200. The annual increment which is part of the existing salary schedule has been raised from \$200 to \$250.

Jobs on the maintenance staff will change from three categories to two in the coming school year. This change in structure was arrived at through agreement of the union, school administration and school board. All maintenance men will be classified whether skilled or semi-skilled with salary minimums and maximums up for both classes.

Operational staff improvements and increments include \$250 raises at both minimum and maximum levels for custodians and heads of buildings.

Salaries janitors will receive a \$250 improvement with the annual increment of \$200 unchanged. Hourly janitors will get slight minimum and maximum salary raises per hour.

Transportation staff improvement is 10 cents an hour.

Cafeteria personnel are paid out of the revenue from lunches served to the children. To keep the lunches at the lowest possible price and to encourage the highest participation in the lunch program, this staff has requested a minimum improvement of five cents an hour with the maximum raised to a sixth year. First year employees will receive \$1.35 with a maximum at \$1.65 at the sixth year.
