

5 Area Graduates Awarded Degrees in U-M Ceremonies

Sixty-five area students were among the 3,668 receiving degrees at the 121st commencement exercises at the University of Michigan.

This does not include degrees awarded by the Law School, Medical School, Flint College or the Dearborn Campus. They will announce their graduates following the completion of their current terms.

The area list included 34 from Livonia, 19 from Plymouth, seven from Garden City, and five from Northville.

The breakdown by degrees among the University of Michigan colleges and schools was: Rackham School of Graduate studies, 925 including 780 Master's and 145 Doctor's degrees; College of Literature, Science and Arts, 1,234; College of Engineering, 313; College of Architecture and Design, 65; School of Education, 294; School of Business Administration, 245; School of Music, 95; School of Nursing, 113; School of Public Health, 128; Public Health Nursing, 4; School of Social Work, 77; School of Natural Resources, 35; School of Pharmacy, 19; School of Dentistry, 76; and Dental Hygiene, 23.
