A distinguished military man will be the featured speaker at Farmington's Memorial Day Ceremony, which will begin at 10 a.m. on Monday, May 31. He is Major General Stanley W. Connelly, Commanding General of the 70th Division. The 70th has its Headquarters at Detroit's Fort Wayne.

A graduate of West Point, Class of 1937, General Connelly also holds an M. S. Degree from Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He has attended a number of military schools, including the Basic Airborne Course, and the Command and General Staff School.
