Extremists Create Tense Conditions

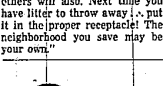
EAST LANSING — The rise of extremist and other pressure groups is creating unprecedented tension for local governments, according to a Michigan State University political scientist.

Dr. Charles R. Adrian said that traditional governing patterns are dissolving in a political environment dominated by right- and left-wing extremists, conservatives, middle-class suburbanites and declining ethnic groups.

"Solving problems," he said, "will have to be done in the oldest and best political tradition — compromise and cooperation. Leaders will have to cooperate with diverse groups, including some persons and groups with whom the leader is not in agreement and for whom he has little respect."

Dr. Adrian, chairman of MSU's political science department, made his remarks before the 42nd Congress of Cities in Detroit.

The Mayor's Committee, Keep Livonia Beautiful, says: "Litter-bugging is contagious. If you throw trash on the streets, others will also. Next time you have litter to throw away, put it in the proper receptacle! The neighborhood you save may be your own."
