The past two years have
been "exciting" for Richard
Bologna, 24, of 30412
Ledgell, Nankin Town-
ship. He is the son of Mr.
and Mrs. Querino Bologna.

He has spent the time
teaching as a member of
the peace corps in Liberia,
West Africa.

For the first year, Bo-
logna was the only volun-
teer in Monrovia, a section
in the interior located
about 40 miles from the
coast. He taught approxi-
mately 55 tribal children
in grades six through 10.

Thus the teaching of the
academic subjects on the high
school level began in the
interior by the govern-
ment to help with a specific
task.
