#### Blue Grasses Relish Rains of Autumn

Noted lawngrasses, such as Kentucky bluegrass, fine fes-cues and the better bentgrasses, mostly set seed in late spring which matures through sum-

mer.

In nature such seed falls to the soil, and is "planted" before good autumn growing weather comes. The system is successful for very good reasons.

First of all, these excellent grasses relish cool weather, do their best autumn and spring.

spring.

An autumn start provides plenty of time for thickening to a tight sod, and for roots to grow deeply, before exhausting summer weather comes.

Then too, cool weather weeds are comparatively few and less contankerous. There won't be a threat of crabgrass until next April or May!

An autumn seeding escapes ne worst weed competition.

There are other favorable factors, too—warm soil, that speeds up sprouting; gentle, penetrating rains most years; less drying out of the seed-bed, because the days are shorter and cooler than in summer.

Its hard to miss in getting a good stand of grass, if you seed your lawn in autumn with a good seed mixture.

Speaking of chemical pesti-cides and safety, the Chemi-cal Specialities Manufactures Association urges gardeners to heed the following hints and re-duce the number of accidents from misuse:

Before opening and using
any pesticide product, note all
warnings on the label
Keep pesticides away from
children and pets and store
them in their original, tightly
closed containers.
Never smoke while spraying
or dusting. Avoid inhaling the
product.

or dusting. Avoid inhaling ine product. Cover bird baths, dog dishes and fish pools before spraying. Use separate equipment for applying hormone-type herbi-cides to avoid injuring suscept-ible plants. Safely dispose of empty con-tainers.

Safely dispose or empty cou-tainers.
Follow directions to keep resi-dues on edible portions of plants within safe limits.
Do not plant edibles near or-namentals that may be sprayed frequently with pesticides.
