Work to Start on Additions in Clarenceville

Construction is expected to get underway soon on additions to two schools in the Clarenceville Public School District. Bids were opened and contracts awarded to projects at Clarenceville Jr. High School and Edgewood Elementary School at the board of education's last two meetings.

Robert and Orr Inc. were awarded the architectural contract. The additions are scheduled to be ready for use starting next September. It is necessary to start building at this time to assure availability when the student population reaches the projected figures for Sept., 1967, a Board spokesman said.

Meanwhile, Board members are visiting school auditoriums in nearby districts as they consider the new Clarenceville High School auditorium, slated to be next on the building program's drawing boards.

In other business at its last meeting, the Board:

- Accepted the resignation of teachers Susan Smith and Betty Crews;
- Appointed Bess Cooley senior high school English department head and Norman Frie Industrial Art department; and
- Studied plans to fence new high school tennis courts.

Plymouth Gal Joins Peace Corps in Bolivia

Sally Fedus, daughter of Mrs. Doris C. Fedus, 3815 Lily Road in Plymouth, has been named a Peace Corps Volunteer, after successfully completing training, and has left for Bolivia.

These are the first Volunteers to start training for their Peace Corps assignments during the summer between their junior and senior years of college.

The program enables future Volunteers to coordinate studies in their final year of college with upcoming overseas assignments. Peace Corps training is resumed immediately after graduation.

The Volunteers will work in rural community development programs in villages throughout the country. The job of a community development worker evolves from the needs of his neighbors. He helps the people collectively define their problems and work together to bring a solution.

With the arrival of this group some 270 Peace Corps Volunteers will be in Bolivia. They will be working in health, university education and agriculture.

During training—summer of 1964 was spent at a Peace Corps camp in Puerto Rico and summer of 1965 at the University of New Mexico—the Volunteers learned Spanish and studied community development skills, agriculture and home economics.

The departing Volunteers join the 10,000 other Peace Corpsmen now working in 46 nations of Asia, Africa and Latin America.

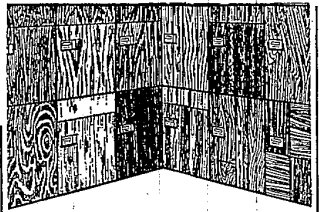

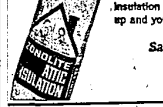
