That is what Mel Dibble did. He had a popular TV program on NBC's Cincinnati station. He started in "Star Hit Machine", "Hi-Lite Hilarities" and other shows. Then he met Billy Graham in 1953 and his TV life ended and he began holding Spiritual Life Crusades in churches.

Beginning Sunday, Oct. 10 and continuing throughout the week Dibble will be speaking in the Redford Baptist Church. Dibble is no stranger to Detroit. He lived here for a period of time while serving as a sales executive.

Billy Graham used Dibble during all of the famous New York Crusade. Mel had charge of the radio and television programs relative to the crusade and served as the emcee of the telecast "Impact".

Another native of Detroit, John Landgraf, with his wife Bobbie, will give leadership to the youth emphasis of the crusade. Both are excellent musicians and are looking forward to coming to Detroit, their former home. Their "Buzz Sessions" and "Youth-A-Rama" are unique approaches in reaching youth. The Landgrafs will be in charge of the music at each of the services during the crusade.

Dibble will speak at all three services both Sundays at 9 a.m., 11:15 a.m. and 7 p.m. The week night services begin at 7:30 p.m.

Congregation Chartered in Livonia

The establishment of a new congregation of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) was made official Oct. 3 by the signing of a church charter. At that time the Livonia Christian Church, which has been meeting regularly as a congregation since March 7, 1955, accepted 14 families as charter members.

Sponsor of the congregation is the Michigan Association of Christian Churches which is affiliated with the International Convention of Christian Churches.

The congregation has been meeting temporarily in the Pierson Elementary School in Livonia. The Rev. John D. Burdett, executive director, minister of the Michigan Association of Christian Churches, has been serving as the organizing pastor. The congregation intends to hire a full time pastor immediately, however.

Order of worship for the charter service included the presentation of the charter, acceptance of new members, and remarks by the Rev. Lawrence H. Maines, executive minister of the Michigan Association of Christian Churches.

The program of the new congregation includes a Church School which meets Sundays at 9:30 a.m. and a worship service at 10 a.m. Mr. Burdett will continue to preside and lead the congregation in pastoral services until the new pastor arrives to assume his duties.

Attendance Campaign Opens Sunday

The annual Church Attendance Emphasis Crusade will be held at the Central Methodist Church of Farmington during October.

During the crusade, each member will be asked to make a Covenant to attend church each Sunday in October. Hilary Smith, chairman of the church's Commission on Membership and Evangelism, will follow these up with letters.

On this Sunday, World-Wide Community Sunday, the congregation will be asked to renew their membership vows.

Under the chairmanship of James T. Jones, each official board member is designated a Fellowship Friend and is responsible for a list of member families. During the month the fellowship friend will serve as a strong arm of the church to constantly interest in the members, and to lead those outside the church into an appreciation of what Christ can mean in their lives.

The observance is symbolic of the present-day partnership that exists between the clergy and laymen who realize that they, too, are the church and are equally responsible for its ministry, according to the Council.
