NEW OFFICERS ELECTED:
Easter Seal Society Aids 522 in Suburbs
Ivan R. McFall, Lincoln Park, was re-elected president of the Easter Seal Society of Western Wayne County at the annual meeting of the Society at the Easter Seal Center Oct. 11. Also re-elected were William Sempiner, Plymouth, first vice-president; T. F. Kuckelman, Belleville, second vice-president; and Alfred J. Hulse, Dearborn, treasurer.
Board members re-elected for two year terms are: Mrs. Louis Hawkins, Taylor; Edward F. Miller, Flat Rock; Edward L. Mills, Wayne; Elsmere V. Pearson, Redford Township; Eugene Perceki, Romulus; Otis Radford, Allen Park; Clive Sunmer and Mrs. Mary Zudick, both of Dearborn.

The Society served 229 crippled children and 221 physically handicapped adults during the fiscal year Sept. 1, 1964 through Aug. 31, 1965. Services offered to individuals one by one, and to individuals in groups included information and referral; transportation to hospitals and clinics; loans of special equipment; purchase of orthopedic shoes and appliances; special planning and consultation; help with fees for diagnostic medical examinations or therapy; and year-round classes and clubs for teen-agers and adults, in addition to a summer Day Camp for crippled children.
Individuals are served regardless of the cause of the physical disability. About one third of the children were cerebral palsied, with 70 other diagnoses included in the list. Fifty-four diagnoses appear among the adults served.

School Age Lists Up In Oakland
For the fifth year in a row the number of school age children in Oakland County has jumped while the number of pre-school children has declined.
In the May census 30 school districts counted 82,087 pre-school children and 256,107 between the ages of five and 18. Last year's figures were 83,179 under the age of five and 245,128 of school age. Every year since 1960, when the pre-school total peaked at 91,124, this age group has become smaller.
The 10,079 gain in number of school-age children is slightly under the 11,223 increase of 1964, but higher than the preceding four years when there was an average annual increase of 8,000 children.
New elementary schools recently built and under construction can be accounted for brief study of the bunching of age groups.
There are more eight-year-olds, 20,115 of them, than any other age group. Seven-year-olds are next, with 18,781 now placed in second and third grades. Ranking next in numbers were 19,222 six-year-olds, 19,091 nine-year-olds, and 19,118 ten-year-olds.
Other districts reporting gains of more than 8 percent were Birmingham, Farmington, Lamphre, Novi, and West Bloomfield.
