**Summer Library Program At Flanders Big Success**

Farmington Public Schools Children in the Flanders School area gobbled up the contents of 1,205 books this summer. They were participants in the Flanders Summer Library Program sponsored by the Flanders PTA.

For the second year, the school library has been open three days a week for eight weeks to all boys and girls within the Flanders School boundaries. Flanders PTA raised funds through a Book Fair and Bake Sale to pay for the services of a professional librarian, Mrs. Kenneth Lachmann.

Some 278 children registered for the summer program, according to Mrs. Lachmann. She conducted three organized story hours each week. Pre-school story time on Mondays was designed for children who had never attended kindergarten. The sessions proved to be valuable language experience opportunities last year and are expected to show similar results in a few weeks when school opens.

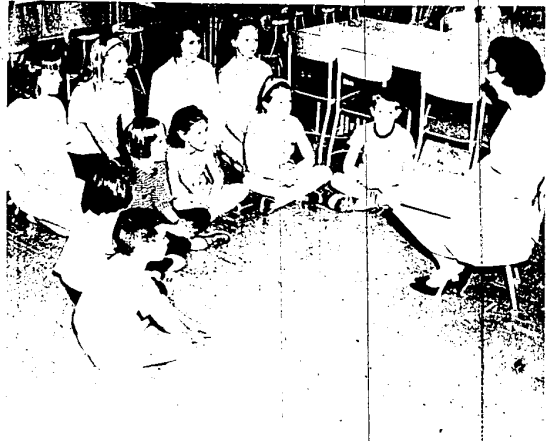
KINDERGARTENERS and first graders had their own story hour on Wednesdays, while Fridays were reserved for second and third graders. Mrs. Lachmann organized a Fun to Read Club for youngsters in grades three through six.

The Fun to Readers made brief reports on printed forms on all the books they read. To qualify for membership, they had to file three reports. Those who went on to make eight reports became "Bookworms" and received special certificates.

In very grown up fashion, the Fun to Readers listened to brief book reviews presented by Mrs. Lachmann. This helped them choose which books to read and competition became keen for some of the more exciting adventure stories.

MRS. LACHMANN never lacked for willing volunteers to help her check out and shelve books. Some ten girls who have just completed sixth grade were on hand most days "just because we like to be here." Some of them think they might like to grow up to be librarians like Mrs. Lachmann.

Making Farmington's school libraries available to residents during the summer is consistent with the Board of Education's philosophy of using school facilities broadly to the interest of residents. Other elementary school libraries that were open one day a week with a volunteer staff were Ten Mile, Eagle and Highmeadow.

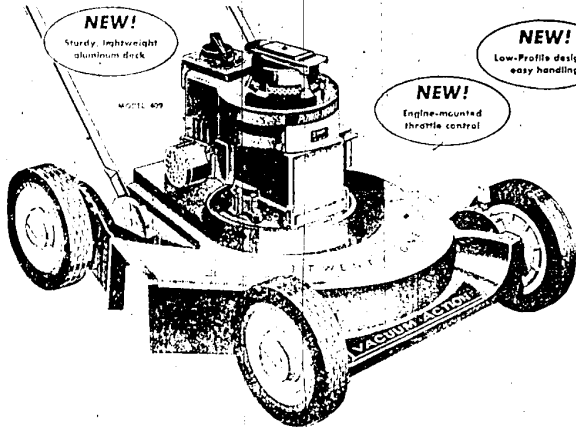

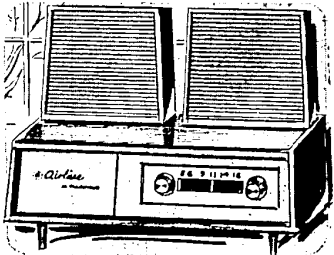
