Subtle Shaping Plus Bolder Colors Lead In Men's Wear

Men's wear for Fall 1965 is off and running. Although the bulk of men's suits are in three main styles — neutral shoulder, classic or the continental — "SHAPE" will be the style of the day. A shaped silhouette suit is a must in your fall wardrobe.

What is a shaped silhouette suit? Basically, it is a jacket with a slight suppression or nip at the waist, a flare at the back and slightly built-up shoulders. All shaped models will carry vents; you can choose from side or center vents. All vents will be deep.

3-button natural shoulder models will feature slight to moderate suppression; most classic models will be 2-button with a slightly traced waist as well as with a suggestion of built-up shoulders; the contin-

ental shaped waist suits will be strong 1-button and 2-button styles trimmed with their usual wide assortment of lapels. Look for fabrics to be gutty and beefy. Typical of the fabrics are sleek, slick hard finished worsteds as well as silks and mohairs blended with worsteds and, infrequently, alone. Showing up, too, are mill-finished worsteds.

To all intents and purposes, this is a one pattern season. Look for bottle greens, too, and plain lustrous blacks. The two leading colors will be blue and brown. Browns will have glints of gold and copper — with a yellow rather

than a red cast. Blues in this category range from deep black-blue to vibrant electric blue.

Sports coats are patternful and livelier than ever but there never were more interestingly colored pinns and nests. Big-brotherly and trashy plaids, checks dominate. Blazers will be bigger and better than ever. Don't overlook the double-breasted blazers. Fabrics include boucles, thick-and-thin weaves, iridescent and flat-look worsteds.

Topcoats go for the shape, too. Latest models are double-breasted fitted coat with L-shaped lapels; a 2-button model with wider notched lapels. Traditional Chesterfields are in semi-fitted style, slim-shouldered full-raglans.
