Birth Control Clinic To Open In Pontiac

Pontiac will open a new birth control clinic on Thursday, January 6, at Room 339 Riker Building, Huron St., Pontiac, Michigan.

The Planned Parenthood League, Inc. of Wayne and Oakland Counties will operate the clinic which will be staffed by a Gynecologist-Obstetrician and a registered professional Nurse. The League also depends on volunteers for much of its work.

Hours will be every Thursday from 12 noon to 7:30 p.m. Patients wishing to see the doctor are asked to be at the clinic at 5 p.m. Patients for supplies only may come to the clinic anytime between 12 noon to 7 p.m. All Pontiac and Pontiac area patients now registered at the William Beaumont-Planned Parenthood clinic at Beaumont Hospital will be transferred to the Pontiac clinic as of January 6.

THE CLINIC WILL offer patients all the medically approved birth control methods and a pre-marital service. Other aspects of the League's work include community education and research field studies working with leading pharmaceutical companies.

The Planned Parenthood League is a non-profit agency, receiving no federal monies and is not a member of the United Fund. It is completely dependent on its own fund raising efforts and patient fees. Patient fees are on a sliding scale according to ability to pay but no one is turned away for lack of funds. All medically approved methods of birth control are available including instruction in the rhythm method.

Formerly Planned Parenthood Pontiac Clinics were located at Pontiac Health Center and Lakeside Homes. These were closed due to inaccessible public transportation. Dr. Harold Furlong and Dr. Palmer Sutton were responsible for locating these early clinics.

Pioneers in the birth control movement in Oakland County were Dr. Palmer E. Sutton of Birmingham and Canon Jatho, Rector, St. James, of St. Johns Episcopal Church, Royal Oak. Working together during the depression on a milk fund for children, they saw first hand the struggles of large families and were responsible for opening the first birth control clinic from practice last year, is advising for the Planned Parenthood League's Beaumont clinic. Canon Jatho is chaplain at Beaumont.

Christmas Card Albums
