# Building Permits Show Marked Increase in 1965

Louis Hechtman, newly elected President of the Builders Association of Metropolitan Detroit announced, "that building permits issued for the first 11 months indicate that 1965 is a

substantially better year than its predecessor. "According to the figures we have been able to ascertain as reliable," Hechtman said, "there have been over 23,000 permits issued this year to Nov. 30, against slightly over 20,000 last year, for the same period.

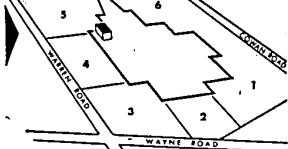

# McEwen to Tell Forum of Township 701 Plans

Those attending the monthly meeting of the Plymouth Businessmen's Forum Tuesday afternoon at the Mayflower Hotel will receive an insight into the proposed 701 development program for Plymouth Township Supervisor John McEwen, who feels the program presented by the Township planners is a tremendous thing, will discuss all phases of the lengthy report.

McEwen is expected to go into statistics which predict the Township will cut up the City in population within 15 years. He also will touch on the recommendations for a Township civic center on North Territorial Road. It was the civic center that drew the most criticism from township residents in a public hearing on the proposed program in December. The hearing was

recessed and will be resumed on Saturday, Jan. 15. The Forum meeting is one of the most attractive in several years.
