## Sportsmen Plan New Classes in Rifle, Pistol

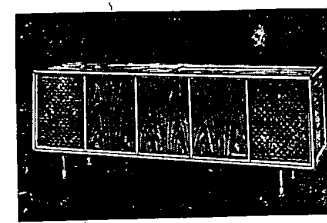
