At this time former Gov. Williams came into the room to ask her to pose with him. "Soapy" had just thrown his hat in the ring for Senator and was beaming. "He's very handsome," said Lana teasingly while Soapy blushed.

She then told us how much fun it was to work in a Ross Hunter production. "He is an absolute perfectionist," she related, and "he loves flowers. He will never use artificial flowers, insists on fresh ones. It is such a glorious feeling to walk on one of his sets and see the gorgeous flowers and smell their fragrance everywhere."

We felt we hit on one of the strongest points of Lana's allure. She is a very feminine person and completely lady-like in her speech and tastes. She likes things to be pleasant, and in good taste. She won't abide smut or crudeness and once walked out on a choice part because of the director's offensiveness.

More than this, she really cares what her public thinks. She got up early, early, in the morning to look like a picture for the press, and she listened attentively to everyone's opinions.

Lana was born to be a star, and in our humble opinion, will be one as long as she lives.
