'CURTAIN GOING UP'
Henrik Ibsen, the pensive 19th Century Norwegian playwright, is gaining new recognition. Students and citizens are rediscovering this Scandinavian version of Edward Albee in the midst of our turbulent 1960's. The latest revival of his masterpiece, "When We Dead Awake" is being performed by the University Players at the Bonstelle Playhouse March 4-March 13.

Other Ibsen plays on the boards, once again include "Peer Gynt" to be done next month at the University of Michigan; "Enemy of the People" has just finished a run at the Jewish Community Center; "Hedda Gabler," "Doll's House," and "The Wild Duck" have been staged by the WPA repertory group. The Scandinavian playwrights are receiving more attention these days. A note from Bradley Morrison, top flight flack agent with the Gurth Theater in Minneapolis, indicates that August Strindberg's "Dance of Death" will be performed in the summer bill of the coming season. Incidentally, the Guthrie Theater this year is going to have a summer bill of three plays ("Dance of Death," "As You Like It," and "Skin of Our Teeth") to be followed by a fall-bill—September through December ("Doctor's Dilemma," O'Neill's "Long Voyage Home").

At Stratford Strindberg's "Dance of Death" will also be presented. Thus, you have two summer locations to catch a play of great power and magnitude if you so desire. Speaking of Stratford reminds me that the box office opened this week for the 14th season. If you want to get tickets for the weekends this summer, NOW is the time to make those reservations. A detailed brochure of the schedule can be obtained by simply writing to the Stratford Box Office. Speed is essential if you want tickets for those weekends.

We seem to have wandered considerably from our opening gambit relative to "When We Dead Awake." And yet such twisting and turning of the mind is entirely appropriate after seeing the opening performance of this seldom-produced work of Ibsen. "When We Dead Awake," written in 1899, was the last play penned by Ibsen. Throughout this experimental work which does ramble philosophically, Ibsen obviously is preparing himself, mentally for his own death. In "The Master Builder" Ibsen began his philosophical inquiry into the realm of religion. This play is filled with mystical comments as to who is the master builder. Can we aspire to compete with him? What is his design for us? "When We Dead Awake" continues the metaphysical discussion. Ibsen ends this final play appropri-
