

**Archbishop Dearden Says  
Mass at St. Alexander's Parish**

Approximately 500 members of St. Alexander's parish in Farmington received the surprise of the week when they attended the 10 a.m. Mass at the church last Sunday.

The relevant of the Mass was the Most Rev. John F. Dearden, Archbishop of Detroit.

Roman Catholics don't usually see their bishop saying Sunday Mass in their home church. He is there when a church or building is dedicated and sometimes to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation, but even that is usually taken care of by one of the Auxiliary Bishops in large dioceses like Detroit.

The Rev. Joseph Ryder, pastor of St. Alexander's, told The Observer that the Archbishop hoped to make an occasional excursion to the parishes to meet with the people.

Fr. Ryder said that he did not know until 10 p.m. on Saturday that the Archbishop would be at the church the next morning, but added that since he was seeking a typical situation in which to meet the people this allowed no time to plan anything out of the ordinary.

While at St. Alexander's the Archbishop visited the parish's family education center.

St. Alexander's, located in Farmington Township, has a total of 550 families living within its boundaries.
