Reasons for Under Achievers

Don't confuse the under-achievers in school with the deprived, Oakland County curriculum directors were warned today.

Dr. Milton W. Beckmann, professor of mathematics education at the University of Nebraska, cited studies that indicate that in general under-achievers have well educated parents. A third of their fathers are college graduates and only a fifth of the fathers did not graduate from high school. Their mothers are predominantly full time housewives and 14 percent of them are college graduates.

In general, the child with better than average intelligence and poorer than average grades, Dr. Beckmann said, come from privileged homes, socially, but possibly inferior psychologically.

The child is pushed for achievement in school to such an extent," he said, "or in such a way that he rebels."
