

Harrison Price Named Manager of Chevy Bumper Plant

Appointment of Harrison T. Price as manager of Chevrolet Motor Division's Spring & Bumper plant at Livonia was announced Monday by Linus J. Rausch, general manufacturing manager.

Price, who has been manager of the division's Manual Transmission plant at Saginaw, succeeds Thomas J. Carroll, who was named manager of manufacturing research and development for Chevrolet with headquarters at Central office in Detroit.

Price joined Chevrolet as a student engineer in 1948 at the Detroit Gear & Axle plant. He was made a production foreman there in 1949, general foreman of production later that year, divisional superintendent of production in 1952 and was assigned to special labor relations projects in 1955.

He was promoted to general superintendent of production at the Saginaw Transmission plant in 1956 and was named operations manager at the Chevrolet-Cleveland Automatic Transmission plant in 1959. He was named manager of the Cleveland plant in 1961 before returning to Chevrolet-Saginaw Transmission in the same capacity.

At Saginaw, Price is a past president and currently a member of the Board of Directors of the Greater Saginaw Chamber of Commerce, a past president of the Greater Saginaw Safety Council, a past president of the Saginaw Exchange Club and a past chairman of the General Motors Saginaw Plant City Committee.

He is a member of the Board of Trustees of Saginaw Osteopathic Hospital and the Saginaw Valley College and is a vice president of Saginaw United Fund. He also is a member of the Board of Directors of the Saginaw Y.M.C.A. and the Downtown Improvement Corporation.

Price's memberships include the Saginaw Country Club, Germania Club, Pioneer Club, Saginaw Lodge 77, F.A.M., Bay City Consistory and El Shinar, Shriners Temple.

A native of Topeka, Kan., Price is a graduate of Harper High School at Chicago and received his bachelor's degree in engineering from Tri-State College at Angola, Ind. He was awarded his master's degree in industrial management from Massachusetts Institute of Technology after completion of studies as a Sloan Fellow.

During World War II Price was an Eighth Air Force fighter pilot in Europe. He left the Air Force with the rank of captain.

Carroll joined Chevrolet in 1949 as a college graduate in training at the division's Six-Cylinder Motor plant at Flint. Successive promotions there made him a junior electrical engineer in 1950, electrical engineer in 1951, maintenance foreman in 1952, superintendent of maintenance in 1954, superintendent of plant engineering in 1955 and production superintendent in 1956.

He moved to Chevrolet's Truck Body and Stamping plant at Indianapolis as production superintendent in 1957 and was

promoted to general superintendent following year. He was elevated to Livonia Forge plant in 1962 Chevrolet-Livonia in 1964.
