The Livonia-Redford Players Guild is busy rehearsing an all-star cast in "You Can't Take It With You." Tony Mattar has assembled a cast of your favorites seen on the local boards for the past 10 years. An early May opening has been set for this classic comedy.

And Bobby Rydell, an extremely versatile performer, is showing his wares (whatever that old cliché means) at the Top Hat in Windsor. Next week Rydell leaves and Bobby Vincent moves into the spotlight there.

While on WKWB in Buffalo he noticed the two-tone stone eagle carved on the facade of the Buffalo Public Library.
