'Wise Guise' Was Smart and Snappy

 "Wise Guise", the ninth annual Redford Suburban League musical, following an "I Spy" theme, kept three capacity audiences in hysterics and gave the show's two comic detectives little opportunity to uncover any dull moments.

Tony Sansone, who donned director logs slanted "Wise Guise" so expertly that it really had snap, crackle, and sizzle. The fast pace never stopped from the opening sensational ending number where a bevy of beauties flew high into the audience on their colorful swings to the closing laugh-racked operation room sequence.

Director Sansone was affectionately known as "J.C." by his fiercely loyal cast. In fact, a collection was taken for sandals, Pinch, and the visually-perfect flowing garments and a half-costuming by Kitty Flynn put
