1/2 cup sugar
2 tablespoons cornstarch
2 cups milk
6 egg yolks, beaten slightly
1 teaspoon vanilla
Combine sugar and cornstarch. Stir in milk. Bring to boil over medium flame, stirring constantly; boil 1 minute. For controlled top burner, select desired flame and set dial at 225". Add some of hot mixture to egg yolks; mix well. Stir into remaining hot mixture. Cook stirring constantly, until thickened. Stir in vanilla. Chill.
