An increasing number of boys and girls across the nation are killed every year in bike accidents. In the Detroit area alone, three children were killed, 506 injured during 1965.

The National Safety Council reports that in the vast majority of bike-car collisions the young-ster, not the driver, is at fault. In four out of five cases he has violated a law or traffic rule.

Most offern, says the Council, the youngster was killed because he mistakenly took the right of way, made an improper turn, or direganded a stop sign or traffic signal. Other causes include riding in the center of the street, on the wrong side of the street facing traffic or while carrying passengers.
