

# Moms Set To Invade Mich. State

Going back to college for a week has undoubted value for homemakers. But Mom's leaving can have value for the rest of the family, too. Youngsters and husbands left on their own for a week tend to find out just how much Mom does that they've taken for granted.

College Week for Women, July 26-29 at Michigan State University, gives Michigan homemakers such an opportunity. The conference is a unique type of adult education. It features a selection of 36 different classes. Several special session speakers have been selected to promote the general theme for 1966, "Target—You and Your Government."

Homemakers who attend will hear Mrs. Martha Griffiths, Michigan's congresswoman, speak on "Woman Power — A Force in the Government." Mrs. Griffiths is in her sixth term in Congress and was previously in the Michigan legislature. She'll speak Thursday evening, July 28, in the MSU auditorium. The session is open to the public.

Current Michigan legislators who will take part in the program will be Raymond Dzendzel, Detroit majority leader of the Senate, and Robert E. Waldron, member of the Michigan House of Representatives. They will participate in a panel discussion with a legislative counselor and a news reporter.

Mrs. Mahlon Shary, East Lansing councilwoman, will also speak at an afternoon session.

Each homemaker attending College Week will choose three classes. Each class meets three times. Instructors for the special classes represent 11 state departments and service organizations and 20 MSU departments.

# State Fair Art Contests Open to All

All resident artists of Michigan are eligible to enter original works in the annual Art Exhibition and Competition to be held at the State Fair which opens Friday, August 26, and runs through September 5 (Labor Day). General manager Walter A. Goodman announced that the show will be greatly expanded this year. Increased area will make possible more exhibits shown to better advantage.

Competition will include three classes: oil-based media, watercolor-based media, and prints. Three prizes — not purchase prizes — of \$125, \$100, and \$75 are to be awarded in each class.

All works should be delivered to the Community Arts Building at the Fairgrounds on or before August 5. Judges will then select the works suitable for exhibition and competition during the Fair.

Preliminary and final judging will be done by Walter McBride, curator of the Grand Rapids Art Gallery, and Jean Dodenhoff, assistant curator, Detroit Institute of Arts.

One entry is allowed from each artist. Only works not previously shown at the State Fair are acceptable. The entry fee of \$3 must accompany the fine arts entry blank which can be obtained from Pauline Harris, Community Arts Department director, Michigan State Fair, Detroit, 48203.
