

Ticket Fixing Case Bound To Circuit Court

The traffic-fixing case involving the top two officers in the Wayne County Sheriff's Department was bound over to Circuit Court Monday by Grand Juror Edward S. Judge Paterson, who presided. Piggins have been committed

and there is probable cause to believe that Buback and Bonmarito are guilty of those charges.

The four counts were permitting traffic fixing, appointing bar owners and persons with criminal records as honorary deputy sheriffs contrary to public policy and the public interest, holding an illegal rally to raise campaign funds and forcing employees to sell and buy tickets for testimonial dinners for Buback and Bonmarito.

Judge Paterson, in his nine-page written opinion, said that his study of the state law as it pertains to the case concerned the meaning of "wilful neglect of duty," which the two defendants were charged.

"I felt that neglect meant inattention, thoughtlessness, and heedlessness," of the official duties of the law enforcement officers," Paterson said.

There was ample evidence that there was wilful neglect of duty, the judge continued, and probably cause that Buback and Bonmarito were guilty.

The defendants' personal bonds will be continued until their trial in Circuit Court, which has yet to be scheduled.

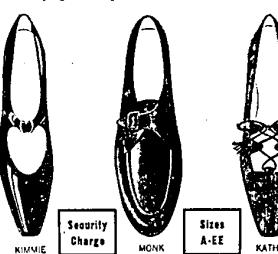
