

Scot Fusiliers List Program

It is said of the Royal Highland Fusiliers that no regiment is more thoroughly Scottish in its makeup, manpower or music.

The Fusiliers, coming to Olympia Stadium for a single performance Sunday, Oct. 8, were born out of strife in their native land, and to this day have all Scotsmen in its service.

The regiment, the Royal Scots Fusiliers when commissioned in 1878, was formed to end the warfare existing between the various clans and between religious groups.

About 100 years later another fighting Scotsman

came into being—the Highland Light Infantry. The two units have served British royalty in nearly every major battle. In 1959 they were merged into the present Royal Highland Fusiliers.

The men of the Fusiliers have been recruited exclusively from the west of Scotland, giving the regiment an all-Scottish enlistment.

Adding to the Scottish tradition is the ancient, stirring music of the highlanders' bagpipes, still performed by the 150 regimental bandmen. The Fusiliers will visit some 50 North American cities on their tour.
