"A general plan for all meals prepared for a week in advance saves time, money and helps avoid dreary, repetitions meals," she says.
Mrs. Sears suggests having well in mind the amounts of foods needed daily by the family. Their needs can be divided into basic food group: milk and milk products; meat, poultry, fish, says, and the family.
